As has been previously discussed with the St. Mark Community in December, I am writing this letter to inform you that St. Mark Catholic Elementary School has grown overcapacity and no longer has classroom space for the expansion of the French Immersion Program on its site beyond September 2017.

In order for the Niagara Catholic District School Board to accommodate the growth of this program for families in the Blessed Trinity and Saint Francis Family of Schools catchment area, as of **Monday, September 4, 2017** the French Immersion Program will move to St. John Catholic School, 5684 King Street, Lincoln, Ontario. Transition meetings and activities for all students enrolled in the French Immersion Program will commence in the 2016-17 school year and will be communicated to the St. Mark and St. John Catholic School communities electronically and in letter format.
