Casual Child and Youth Worker

The Niagara Catholic District School Board is currently seeking Casual Child and Youth Workers

PRIMARY FUNCTION:

A Child and Youth Worker (CYW) works as a member of the Mental Health and Well-Being team at the school level. The primary role is to support the social, emotional and/or behavioural well being of students. The CYW provides intervention strategies and coordinates appropriate community referrals. By implementing a team approach, students will be supported in a professional and confidential manner.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Completion of a three year, post-secondary diploma in a Child and Youth Care program or equivalent.
- Up to three months related employment or volunteer experience with children.
- First aid, CPR, and intervention strategies.
- Team-oriented person with well-developed interpersonal skills.
- Knowledge of community agencies and organizations.
- Working understanding of related hardware and software.
- In addition, may be called upon to perform other duties/responsibilities comparable to the above as the above describes only the typical primary features of this position.

LOCATIONS: Must be able to travel to all locations within the Niagara Catholic District School Board jurisdiction.

HOURS PER WEEK: Must be available Monday to Friday for Elementary School hours.
