5. Community Round Table

Niagara Peninsula Aboriginal Area Management Board (NPAAMB)

- Programming is running such as construction and healthcare.
- Students are in class on a rotating basis

Niagara Regional Native Centre (NRNC)

- Still working from home but programs are running.
- Upcoming events are Halloween party tonight, toonie auction Nov 20th, Children's Christmas Sat. Dec. 5th, Community Christmas dinner Dec. 10th.

Niagara Chapter of Native Women (NCNW)

- A new Indigenous pandemic outreach worker has been hired through relief funds to provide ppe, food and other items to community members in need.
- Programs are running virtually
- Attackers and blockers program for Indigenous women in sports leadership
- There will be something for holiday celebration but no details yet.
- The AGM was virtual this year and went well
- Most are still working from home with staff occasionally in the office.

Fort Erie Native Friendship Centre (FENFC)

- There are in person and virtual programs running currently.
- Dance workshop was run in person with socially distanced protocol
- Halloween costume contest with several dozen entrants, prizes and candy for the young ones.
- Have still been able to maintain strong connection to community members and the food program is going very strong.
- Courage to Soar program is running and in person
- Offering as much as possible without exposing community to risks

Niagara College

- Staff working from home
- Programs running such as Indigenous education connect, soup lunch Wednesday, Elder connects with Dave and Elaine weekly
- There is an Indigenous culture safety 101 course for faculty, fireside chat series on Mondays from 7 – 9
- Indigenous Awareness month in November where students, staff and faculty will learn about Indigenous culture, Indian Horse book club, Treaty Week plans and partnering with the library, Louis Riel Day, Inuit Day and Aboriginal Veterans Day

Niagara Region Métis Council (NRMC)

- The Métis nation provided financial support to councils and giving out food cards to citizens three times so far with another to be provided along with ppe supplies.
- Staffing has continued but meetings are virtual.
- There was a Balls Falls camp, education programming has continued online, and they are preparing for Louis Riel Day.
