Superintendent Forsyth-Sells reported that as approved at the NCPIC Meeting of November 4, 2021, Niagara Catholic has renewed the 2022-2023 OAPCE Membership (56 x \$70 per school=\$3920.00).

Superintendent Forsyth-Sells shared that Diane Zlomislic has resigned as a parent member of the NCPIC and as the OAPCE Regional Director for the Niagara Catholic District School Board. As a result, at the NCPIC meeting of November 3, 2022 an election will take place to fill the (1 year) vacancy for the 2022-2023 school year.

# 6. NCPIC Financial Report

Superintendent Forsyth-Sells reported that the Ministry of Education has provided funds to all Parent Involvement Committees to support parent engagement. The opening balance for the NCPIC is 9285.44.

Superintendent Forsyth-Sells also reported that the Ministry of Education also provided funds to school boards through the GSN to support parent engagement. Niagara Catholic has received \$30,500 to support parent engagement projects for the 2022-2023 school year.
