Although full integration is our ultimate goal, vehicles of a variety of sizes and other assistive/safety devices are made available to meet the integrated accessibility needs of each student of the Board.
Future/Intended Projects/Accomplishments	The Board is committed to continuing to ensure that accessible transportation services are provided to students with disabilities by:
	 Continuing to develop individual student transportation plans. Making available to the public current information on accessibility equipment and features on school transportation vehicles, routes and services. Deploying lifting devices and ramps upon request, ensuring adequate time is provided to safely board, assisting with safe and careful storage of assistive devices, and allowing persons with a disability to travel with medical aid. Continuing to work with all stakeholders on finding solutions as we support increasingly complex transportation needs.
Employment (HUMAN RESOURCES)	Requires that employers must make their workplace and employment practices accessible to potential or current employees with disabilities. For example, employers that make an offer of employment to a successful job applicant must inform the applicant of their organization's policies for accommodating employees with disabilities.
