#### WHAT IS AN ATTENDANCE AREA REVIEW (AAR)?

St. Martin

An AAR is conducted by the school board to alter the existing boundary of a school or group of schools due to changes in student enrolment, program demands, new school construction or other factors. An ad hoc AAR Committee carries out the attendance area review process. Attendance area reviews follow a Board-approved process out lined in the <a href="Attendance Area Policy">Attendance Area Policy</a>, 301.3, which includes a public consultation process when impacting existing students. The purpose of this AAR is a result of a new Catholic elementary school in the Town of Lincoln (Beamsville), located on Greenlane Road, east of Ontario Street, being added to the Blessed Trinity Family of Schools complement. It is anticipated that the school will be open for the 2025/2026 school year.

Niagara Catholic has secured funding for new Catholic Elementary School in the Town of Lincoln (Beamsville), located on Greenlane Road, east of Ontario Street. The points below outline how the project has evolved since initial Ministry of Education approval.

#### 2021

Niagara Catholic has secured funding for new Catholic elementary school in the Town of Lincoln (Beamsville), through the Capital Priorities Grant program. Niagara Catholic was successful, and the Ministry of Education approved funding of \$10,108.084 for a 421 pupil place school.

#### 2022-2023

Due to an increase in child care need, Niagara Catholic submitted an application to the Ministry of Education requesting that the existing approval for the elementary school be expanded to include a three-room child care centre.

On April 6, 2023, the Ministry of Education approved this request and provided additional funding of \$2,014,523 for a child care centre.
